The Trustees decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

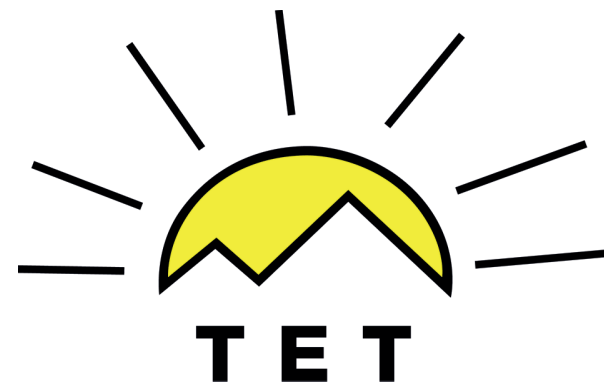

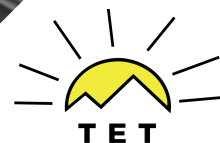


## TERTIARY AND TRADE SCHOLARSHIP 2025

## CONDITIONS OF GRANTS

- The Scholarship shall be known as the TET Tertiary and Trade Scholarship.
- The Scholarship shall be open to all students whose parents or caregivers reside in the TET area. Preference will be given to those students who attend a school in the TET area.
- The student must have completed a minimum of 3 years secondary education.
- The application must be endorsed by the school principal or senior school teacher.
- The Scholarship is available for students attending any tertiary institution.
- The Scholarship is NOT available for agriculture or horticulture courses.
- Each Scholarship is worth up to \$3000 and is available for the first year of study only.
- Applications for other Scholarships will not prejudice applications.
- If successful, funds will be paid directly to the student's nominated bank account upon receipt of the relevant paid accounts. These funds may be progressively drawn upon.

## CONDITIONS OF GRANTS

- Payment is for accommodation and course materials but not IT equipment.
- Successful recipients who do not complete their first year of study must return the full amount of the scholarship to the Taranaki Electricity Trust.
- Applications from students not having completed three years secondary education, but commencing an approved apprenticeship, may be considered at the Trustees' discretion.
- Applications should be made on the TET general application form and can be lodged at any time during the year, however the applicant must be a student at school at the time that the application is submitted.

Register as a new User, and answer No to the first question "Are you applying on behalf of an Organisation". Once you have been approved as a new user, login to the system and under "Apply for Funding", click "Apply Now" under the "Scholarship Grant Application" section.

Applications must be received at the TET office by 5pm on 13th October 2025. All applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application by 26th November 2025.
