Nominations open for Taranaki Electricity Trust Election of Trustees

Nominations are now open for the Taranaki Electricity Trust's triennial election, and will remain open until 12 noon, Friday 21 April 2023.

The Trust district is divided into two wards:

- Ward A (part of the New Plymouth District Council area including Waitara, Uruti and Inglewood); and
- Ward B (parts of the Stratford and South Taranaki District Council areas including Stratford and Eltham).

Elections are being held for six positions on the Trust (three positions from Ward A and three positions from Ward B) on Friday 16 June 2023.

To be eligible to stand, a candidate for the Taranaki Electricity Trust must be enrolled as a parliamentary elector and resident within the respective ward of the Taranaki Electricity Trust district and be nominated by two parliamentary electors of the respective ward of the Trust district.

Nomination papers must be in the hands of the electoral officer not later than 12 noon, Friday 21 April 2023. Completed nomination papers can be returned:

- by post to Independent Election Services, PO Box 5135, Victoria Street West, Auckland 1142; or
- by hand to the Taranaki Electricity Trust Office, 84 Rata Street, Inglewood during office hours of 9:30am-12:30pm on Wednesdays and Fridays; or
- by email to nominations@electionservices.co.nz

Voting documents will be delivered from Friday 12 May 2023 to approximately 20,000 electors in the Taranaki Electricity Trust district.
