



2025 TET TERTIARY and TRADE SCHOLARSHIP

Terms & Conditions

Conditions of Grants

The Scholarship shall be known as the TET Tertiary and Trade Scholarship

- 1 The Scholarship shall be open to all students, who alongside their parents or caregivers, reside in the TET area. Preference will be given to those students who attend a school in the TET area.
- 2 The Student must have completed a minimum of three years secondary education.
- 3 Before any Scholarship is awarded, TET will seek an independent endorsement from the school principal or senior school teacher.
- 4 The Scholarship is available for students attending any tertiary institution, or enrolling through an Industry Training Organisation.
- 5 The Scholarship is **NOT** available for agriculture or horticulture courses.
- 6 Each Scholarship is worth **up to \$3,000.00** and is available for the **first year of study only**.
- 7 Applications for other Scholarships will not prejudice applications.
- 8 If successful, funds will be paid directly to the student's nominated bank account upon receipt of confirmation of enrolment and the relevant paid **invoices and statements**. The funds may be progressively drawn down.
- 9 The Scholarship is for accommodation and course materials which are deemed by the Trustees as being essential to the course. IT equipment is no longer covered by the scholarship.
- 10 The Scholarship can **not** be used to purchase mobile phones.
- 11 Applications from pupils not having completed three years secondary education, but commencing an approved apprenticeship, may be considered at the Trustees discretion. Applicants seeking funding to assist with costs while undertaking an apprenticeship should apply on the TET general application form. These can be lodged at any time during the year, however the applicant must be a student attending school at the time that the application is submitted.
- 12 Applications are open now.
- 13 Applications close at 5pm on 13 October 2025.
- 14 Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the Trustees. Late applications will not be considered. The Trustees decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 15 All applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application by 26 November 2025.
- 16 All applications must be submitted on TET's online application portal: https://tet.fluxx.io/user_sessions/new. Register as a new User, and answer No to the first question "Are you applying on behalf of an Organisation". Once you have been approved as a new user, login to the system and under "Apply for Funding" "Apply Now" under the "Scholarship Grant Application" section.
Only applications completed in full will be processed, which includes two signed letters of support and proof of your bank account number.
- 17 Should the Scholarship recipient not complete their first year of studies, they agree to **return the full amount** of the Scholarship to the Taranaki Electricity Trust.
