Election of Chairman

Engagement with the wider community and schools is increasing, with funding from other sources also assisting in bringing the Marae back up to condition. Boon will project manage the restoration.

The amendment then became the substantive motion, it was put to the meeting and carried. \$100,000.00 relates to various professional and design fees and \$50,000.00 relates to operational costs.
