

## 2020 TET TERTIARY and TRADE SCHOLARSHIP Terms & Conditions

## **Conditions of Grants**

The Scholarship shall be known as the TET Tertiary and Trade Scholarship

- The Scholarship shall be open to all students whose parents or caregivers reside in the TET area. Preference will be given to those students who attend a school in the TET area.
- 2 The Student must have completed 3 years secondary education.
- The application must be endorsed by the school principal or senior school teacher.
- 4 The Scholarship is available for students attending any tertiary institution.
- 5 The Scholarship is **NOT** available for agriculture or horticulture courses.
- 6 Each Scholarship is worth up to \$2,000.00 and is available for the first year of study only.
- 7 Applications for other Scholarships will not prejudice applications.
- If successful, funds will be paid directly to the student's nominated bank account upon receipt of the relevant paid **invoices and statements**. The funds may be progressively drawn upon.
- The Scholarship is for accommodation and course materials/equipment which are deemed by the Trustees as being essential to the course.
- 10 The Scholarship can **not** be used for residential hall placement deposits or to purchase mobile phones.
- Applications from pupils not having completed three years secondary education, but commencing an approved apprenticeship, may be considered at the Trustees discretion. Applicants seeking funding to assist with costs while undertaking an apprenticeship should apply on the TET general application form. These can be lodged at any time during the year, however the applicant must be a student or recent school leaver at the time that the application is submitted.
- 12 Applications open on 24 August 2020.
- 13 Applications close at 3pm on 14 October 2020.
- Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the Trustees. Late applications will not be considered. The Trustees decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 15 All applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application by 30 November 2020.

  Only applications which meet the following criteria will be processed
  - Applications must be typed
  - Letters of support/references must be signed by the referee
  - Applications must be submitted as a SINGLE file in pdf only, no other format will be accepted
    (application first, followed by letters of support and then proof of bank account number either an
    encoded deposit slip or copy of a bank statement. Please do not include the TET Terms and
    conditions as part of your application. Subject line should read 'Tertiary Scholarship Application,
    followed by the name of the applicant').
- 17 Should the Scholarship recipient not complete their first year of studies, they agree to **return the full amount** of the Scholarship to the Taranaki Electricity Trust.
